A staple of the Lean Together™ program has been the learning from facility tours. You can look forward to 5 site visits as part of Advanced. In addition to seeing the 2 second lean progress and excitement at other companies, your learning will broaden and deepen while gaining practical experience as you tour in a 'gemba walk' style. You'll be prepared to keenly observe, question, objectively challenge, and offer new insights and perspectives of a targeted area or process - to benefit the host company and all in the group.

Coaching Session and 'Coach the Coach' Onsite Assistance

During a group classroom session, explore the difference between leading, supervising, and coaching. Through interactive exercises, you will identify which is happening most often in your 2 second lean implementation and learn an effective process for coaching that can be transferred throughout your leadership team.

With an NWIRC coach onsite at your facility, you will have the opportunity to reinforce and sharpen essential coaching skills to strengthen the 2 second lean commitment and participation of employees - whether newly hired or to long-standing employees. Or, elect to bring the Coaching Classroom Session to your site for other supervisors and managers in your organization.

Project Management Session and Onsite Assistance

Successful project management requires more than coordinating activities in hopes of staying on time and budget. During a group classroom session, you will learn the key principles, tools and techniques to manage people and activities including planning, control, monitoring, and review in order to achieve defined objectives.

Then, during a scheduled 2-hour session on site at your facility, NWIRC's subject matter expert will provide assistance tailored to your specific needs and priorities. Areas of focus can include: managing your pipeline of ideas, prioritizing, communicating, team-building, gaining management support, and planning.
